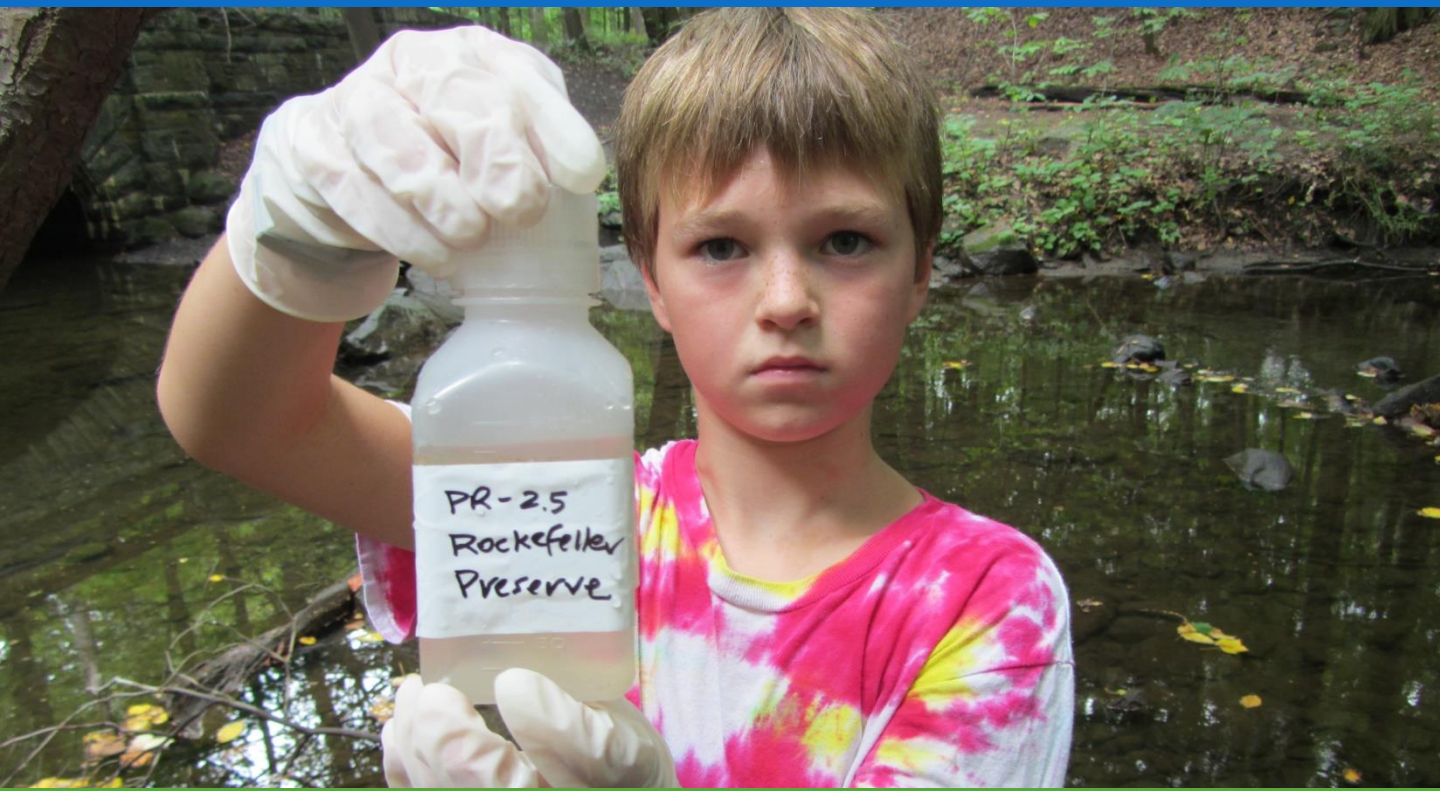


Lower Hudson Urban Waters Summit
