
# HOW TO READ YOUR NYSEG BILL



### **#1 ACCOUNT & POD #:**

Please note that you have an account number and a point of delivery identification number (PoD #).

### **#2 NYSEG ENERGY CHARGES:**

The total amount charged by the utility (NYSEG) for the use of its lines to deliver electricity to your home. This is actually a delivery charge.

### **#3 DIRECT ENERGY SUPPLY:**

The total amount charged for the electricity supply through the Westchester Power CCA.

### **#4 ESCO SUPPLY SERVICE:**

This is the energy supply company (ESCO) selected by Westchester Power CCA.

### **#5 TYPE OF METER READ:**

This describes whether the meter reading was actual (A) or estimated (E). This is used in the graph below, titled "Historical Electricity Consumption," which illustrates your 12-month usage.

## #6 ELECTRICITY DELIVERY CHARGES AND TOTAL ENERGY CHARGES:

This is the breakdown and total amount of delivery charges from the utility, including taxes and surcharges. This is called "energy charges" on page one, known as "delivery charges."

#### **#7 WEATHER TABLE:**

This demonstrates how weather may affect your energy consumption.

### **#8 ELECTRICITY SUPPLY DETAIL:**

This refers to the energy supplier selected by the Westchester Power CCA.

### **#9 CUSTOMER CHARGE @KWH:**

This is the total cost of your energy supply, which includes the fixed rate per kWh and the taxes required by New York State.
