


ConEd Example

\$150 is the total electricity charge for this ConEd participant:

1. **\$100 solar credit saving** is earned by the participant
2. **\$90 subscription fee** goes back to the solar project and utility
3. **\$10 is retained (10% of the solar credit)** by the participant, called **“Adjustments”**
4. **\$140 is paid by the participant in total**, resulting in a **\$10 savings on the total electricity bill this month!**
