


NYSEG example

\$150 total electricity charge is due on this NYSEG participant's bill this month:

1. **\$100 solar credit saving** is earned by the participant and applied to their bill, titled "**CDG Value Stack Credit**"
2. **\$90 subscription fee** is deducted, titled "**CDG Subscription fee**"
3. **\$10 is retained** by the participant (**10% of the solar credit savings**)
4. **\$140 is paid by the participant in total**, resulting in a **\$10 savings on the total electricity bill this month!**
